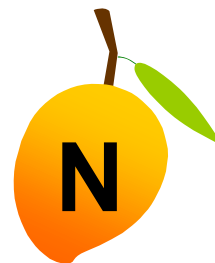


LEAP FROG

NUMBER SENSE



OBJECTIVE: Students will locate numbers on a number line using key words like: above, below, between, next to, behind, in front of.

SUPPLIES:

- ◆ 4 number lines
- ◆ 4 frogs
- ◆ Leap Frog direction cards

APPROXIMATE TIME: 10 minutes

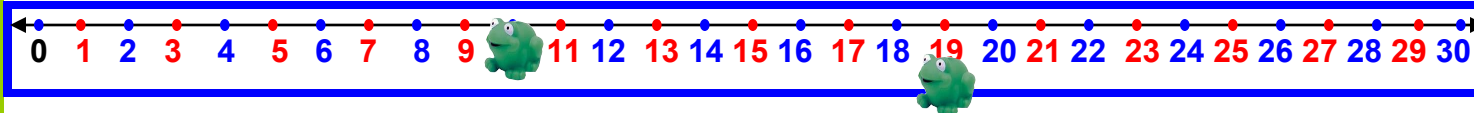
NUMBER OF PLAYERS: 1 to 4

TEACHING TIPS:

Each student will need a frog and a number line. Lay the number line out flat in front of each player, and place direction cards face down in the middle of the players. Taking turns, players will draw a card to be read aloud. The player or an adult may read the card.

All players will place their frog onto the correct number on their number line. Once all frogs are placed the player who drew the card will state the number the frog should be sitting on.

If there is a wrong answer, read the card again and talk about the key word and the number order to assist the player.
